

Standard Club Ladies Golf Association Bylaws

Proposed 4/1/2019

Article I – NAME

The name of the association is the Standard Club Ladies Golf Association (“Association”).

Article II – PURPOSE

Sec. 1 The mission of the Association is to encourage enjoyment of the game of golf and to familiarize players with the rules, good sportsmanship and etiquette of the game. The Association and its members will adhere to the USGA Rules of Golf except as modified by the local rules.

ARTICLE III - ORGANIZATION

Sec. 1 The business of the Association shall be conducted by the Board of Directors (“Board”), shall consist of five voting members: the elected officers and the 9-Hole League Representative (appointed for a one-year term by the President). The Board may be increased or decreased in number as deemed necessary.

Sec. 2 Meetings of the Board may be called at any time by order of the President or by any three members of the Board.

Sec. 3 There will be an opening and closing meeting of the full membership held annually.

Sec. 4 The Association will include two leagues: the 18-Hole League and the 9-Hole League.

ARTICLE IV - AMENDMENTS

Sec. 1 The Bylaws may be amended at the opening or closing meeting of the full membership. A simple majority vote of the members present is required for the adoption of the amendment. Any amendment must be presented in writing sent via email to the full membership no less than seven days prior to that vote.

ARTICLE V - POLICIES

Sec. 1 The Board may establish such policies as become necessary to conduct the affairs of the Association. Any such policy will be sent by e-mail to the full membership and shall remain effective until modified or revoked by future Boards of Directors. A majority of the board must be present to vote on any policy change.

ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

Sec. 1 To become a member of the Association one must have paid into the Handicap Trophy Fund (“HTF”). To be eligible for the HTF, you must be an adult member that carries a USGA handicap at Standard Club. A person may join the association at any time of the year.

Sec. 2 Members must post ALL scores, including but not limited to Association weekly events, special events and away scores. Any round of golf played away from Standard Club at a Course with a rating and slope must be posted per USGA guidelines. Members are responsible for posting their own score unless advised differently by the professional staff, including and not limited to Standard scores.

ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS

Sec. 1 Those members of the Association present at the closing meeting shall elect the officers of the Association. At a minimum, the officers will consist of a President, a Vice President, a Treasurer, and a Secretary. The outgoing President may serve as a non-voting advisor to the Board.

Sec. 2 The Officers are elected for a two-year term of office. The President and Treasurer will be elected in odd calendar years and the Vice President and Secretary will be elected in even calendar years.

Sec. 3 The President will preside at all meetings of the Association and of the Board. The President shall have general supervision of all the affairs of the Association. In the absence of the President, the Vice President shall perform these duties.

Sec. 4 The Vice President shall assist the President and perform the duties of President in the absence or inability of the President to act. The Vice President shall act as the Tournament Chair.

Sec. 5 The Treasurer, in conjunction with the General Manager of the Standard Club, shall account for funds of the Association and distribute them as directed by the Board. She shall make financial reports to the full membership present at the opening and closing meetings.

Sec. 6 The Secretary shall record and keep the Minutes of Board and full meetings; keep all records of the Association; and handle necessary correspondence and announcements.

Sec. 7 The President shall appoint a nominating committee consisting of three association members. The nominating committee shall designate its own chair person. The nominating committee shall prepare a slate of officers to be communicated at least 14 days prior to the annual closing meeting. Additional candidates may be nominated from the floor at the time of the election.

ARTICLE VIII – VOTING

Sec. 1 Voting for the election of the Officers of the Association Board shall be done in person at the annual closing meeting.

Sec. 2 Motions proposed, elections of Officers, and Bylaws amendments will be decided by a simple majority of the members present at the annual closing meeting.
