This award will be presented to five students from the parish of St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Lexington, MA., in honor of Frank's life of love and service to his church, his community and, serendipitously, to people in general. From his childhood as an altar boy in Greece to his half century serving St. Nicholas as steward, volunteer and parish council president, Frank was "The Servant" who opened the church and prepared the sanctuary each Sunday* and treasured his favorite role as Santa. Frank greeted, advised, comforted, consoled, embraced and cheered young and old at St. Nicholas. In the community, he worked tirelessly in many philanthropic organizations and joyfully extended a helping hand to young people, mentoring them in their career and personal paths. His first response to any situation was "How can I help?"

In the spirit of Frank's generous and helpful nature, the Frank Fotis Award will be given to aid in educational expenses of five St. Nicholas parish college and graduate students who are inspired by Frank's dedication to serving others with joy. Five \$500 scholarships will be awarded.
