WHAT TO EXPECT

The founder of Scouting, Lord Baden Powell, described Scouting as a game with a purpose. Wood Badge is the best, most effective game you will ever play as a Scout leader. The course is a two-step process consisting of a practical phase followed by an application phase. The practical portion (the 6-day course) will take place both in the classroom and in the outdoors. This experience will provide a deeper understanding of Scouting and the impact it can have on the youth in your unit and in your community.

The application phase will take place after the course is complete. Participants will write a contract with themselves during the course. This contract is called a "Ticket". The Ticket is written prior to the end of the course and is the method you will use to bring your experience home to your Scouting world.

Participants will have up to 18 months to complete their Wood Badge Ticket. Upon completion, the Wood Badge beads, woogie, and neckerchief are awarded.

The course is 6 fun-filled days: two 3-day weekends. Plan to arrive by 7am on Friday and depart at 5:30pm on Sunday.
