

POLICE PATROL HIGHLIGHTS

- On February 5, a suspicious male subject was reported to be acting 'strange' and hiding merchandise items inside a business in the 300 block of 5th Street. Employees suspected the subject was preparing to steal the items. When officers arrived, they found Adam Jilano in the dressing room with several clothing items. Upon detaining Jilano, he resisted arrest and was taken into custody. Jilano was booked into Yuba County Jail.
- On February 14, patrol officers assisted probation officers with the arrest of Angel Zavala in the 1600 block of Freeman Street. Angel was attempting to manufacture Honey Oil.
- On February 16, PD received a report of gun shots fired in the 500 block of I St and a subject who was shot in the leg. Officers arrived on the scene, located shell casings in the street, blood on the sidewalk, and no suspect or victim. While contacting witnesses and processing the scene, Adventist Health-Rideout Emergency personnel contacted dispatch and notified PD that the victim had arrived at the hospital. The juvenile victim, who was also an escapee from Juvenile Hall, was transported to UC Davis with non-life threatening injuries. The investigation is ongoing.
- On February 20, a suspect was arrested in the 2300 block of Cumisky Street for sexually assaulting a minor under the age of 14. The investigation is ongoing.
