

# Rosario starts a business round with US businessmen

The cities of Saint Louis and Rosario celebrated their twinning after the signing of the document by the Secretary of Government of the Municipality, Gustavo Leone and Sheila Sweeney, general director of the Economic Development Agency of the mentioned town of the state of Missouri, United States .

"I want to welcome the delegation that visits us and highlight the importance of these agreements to continue strengthening ties and bonds," said Leone, representing the Municipality of Rosario. "Both cities share similar economic profiles, while we Rosario are at the forefront of sports and culture as Saint Louis, so we have aspects that can find us working together," he added.

In addition, he remarked the nature of twinning as a joint work agreement when addressing common problems and challenges, and also praised the "political decision of two state levels that are committed to work together."

"They are two ideal cities to be twinned by their economic base, both are logistical and distribution centers located on the banks of important rivers, but

the most important thing is the spirit of innovation that the two communities encourage, encourage and embrace," said Sheila Sweeney.

He also clarified that the signing of this twinning "is more than a recognition of similarities, it is a challenge to see what we can achieve together, there is much to learn from each other, and our shared opportunities enrich our economic, cultural communities. and academically. "

After the speeches, the authorities proceeded to sign the agreement that Mónica Fein had already signed during a reception that took place at the United States Embassy in Buenos Aires.
