Jeff Karoub has lived a life of words and music in Michigan, mostly in and around Detroit. The multi-instrumentalist is a melding of Motown, northern Michigan and the Middle East and brings it all to bear in a catalog of five albums and multiple singles that have earned him interviews and airplay on radio stations and venues and festivals across the globe.

The son of a French horn player who graced the Detroit Symphony Orchestra stage and Motown Records studio, Jeff mines song ideas from both his family's history and the people and places he has chronicled as a longtime journalist and author. He was chosen as a featured performer during The Big Read Dearborn 2018, a National Endowment for the Arts-funded program exploring immigrant experiences through culture and literature. In 2022, he performed two sets at the Kaustinen Folk Festival in Finland, the largest gathering of its kind in the Nordic Region.

He performs both solo and as part of a band called Garrison Corner.
