We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead. 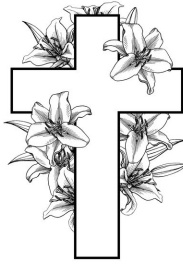
