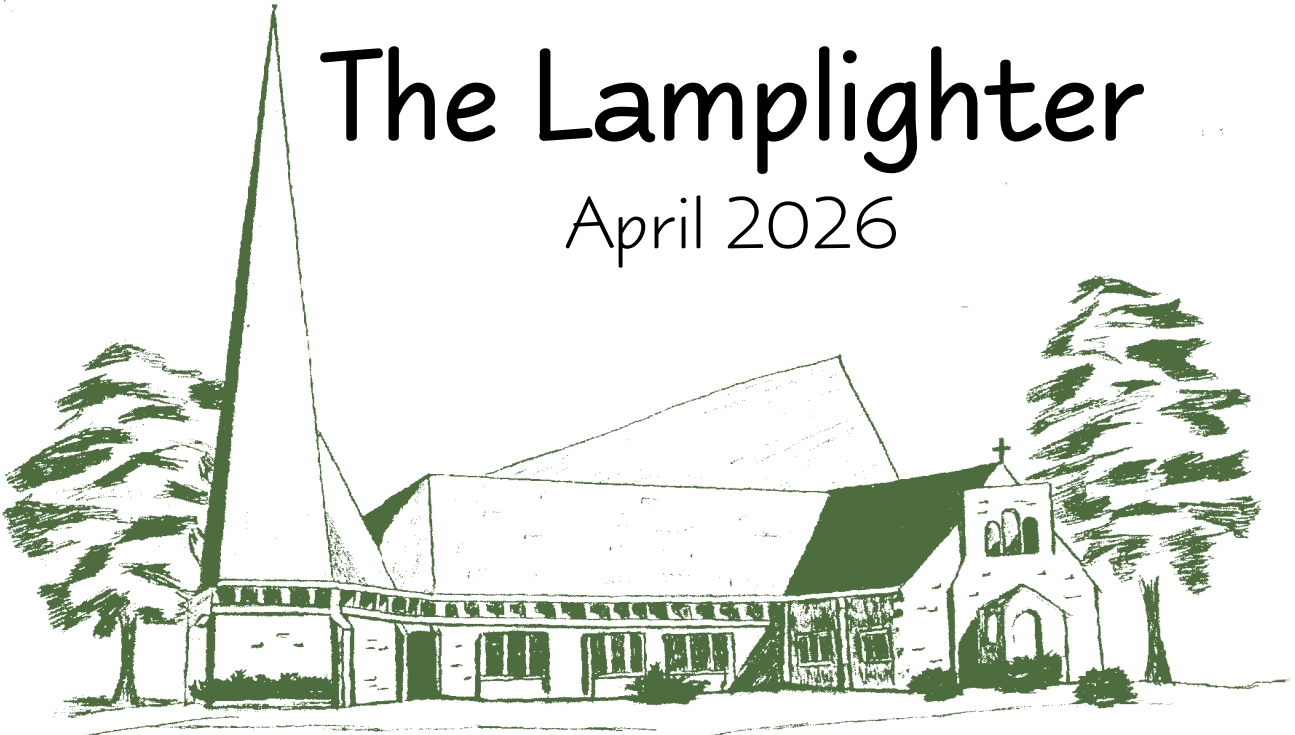

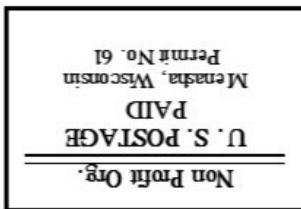

There are two exciting, new opportunities this Easter season at St. Thomas you won't want to miss. So, mark your calendars and plan to join us!

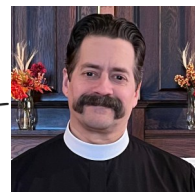
- We will be celebrating the Second Sunday of Easter (April 12th) as a Patronal Feast at St. Thomas – that is, a feast of our Patron Saint, Thomas the Apostle. To mark this day, we'll have a single service at 9:00am, immediately followed by a brunch our vestry is planning for us. We'll also hold a silent auction for an 8x10 icon of St. Thomas I'm currently writing. The proceeds from that auction will go to support our new Choral Scholarship Program, which has already become a great blessing in our worship. So, please plan to join us for worship, food, and fellowship on April 12th!

- For the past few months, I've been talking with Fr. Tom Reynebeau from St. Patrick's (across the street) about a possible ecumenical study. So, I'm excited to now announce that he and I will be co-leading a three-week study in May, titled **"Everyday Merton: Resurrecting the Spiritual Life."** For those who are unfamiliar with his work, Fr. Thomas Merton, OCSO, was an influential 20th century Trappist monk who wrote extensively about Christian spiritual life and its practices. The focus of our studies will be two of the many topics Thomas Merton wrote about: **Contemplation and Spiritual Direction.** These are two, often misunderstood, pieces of the spiritual life; that, when understood and appropriately employed, can benefit us tremendously in everyday discipleship. In addition to conversations about Merton and spiritual practice, Fr. Tom and I will take time to answer questions about the similarities and differences between our two expressions of the Christian Faith. St. Thomas will host the first and third studies and St. Patrick's will host the second. So, please plan to join us and our neighbors for this exciting new opportunity in May!

Chosen Bible Study Group

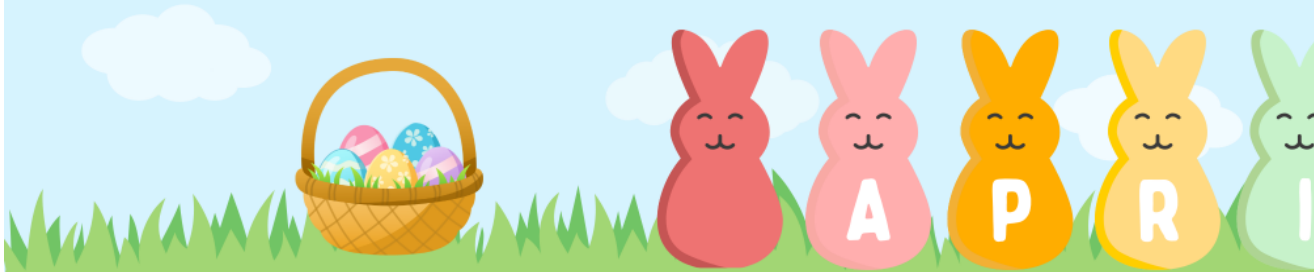

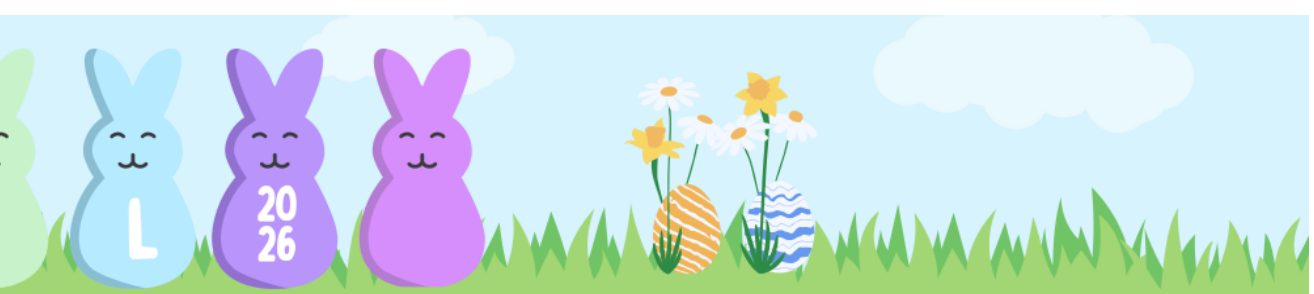

Spring is in the air and Double Portion Soup Kitchen is a busy place, as usual. As a collaborative partnership between St. Thomas Episcopal Church, St. Patrick’s Catholic Church, and Calvary Bible Church, we prepare and serve a free community meal every Monday, Wednesday and Thursday for our neighbors in need of nourishment and fellowship. We are grateful for this valuable partnership, for the St. Patrick’s Church Cooks and the Home Cooks who regularly provide delicious meals ready to serve to our guests, for Manderfield’s and Panera Bakeries who donate baked goods every week, and for the dedicated volunteers who donate their time and talent to prepare and serve a nutritious meal three times each week.

In addition to the lunch service, we maintain a free pantry with both food and hygiene items that guests can take home. If you would like to support our pantry of shelf stable food items that help our neighbors bridge the gap between our three meal services per week, please consider adding a few items to your next grocery store trip and leave them in a bag on the kitchen island at the St. Thomas Church kitchen. We are always in need of canned fruit, jams and jelly, cereal, hearty soups, beef stew, canned chicken, ramen noodles, laundry detergent pods, and hygiene items. If you prefer to make a tax-deductible donation, we are happy to shop for you. MOTHERS' MERCY HOME

PARTNERSHIP — *March Update*

We recently received updates on the children who are partnered through our Mothers' Mercy Home Partnership Program. Franka Doyen also provided the following information:

Our sponsorships cover a portion of the costs for school fees, school uniforms and learning materials. They continue until the child graduates from school at approximately 19 years of age, the age of majority. Franka Doyen, the sponsorship coordinator, regularly informs the Partner about their child's progress. At the time of graduation from secondary school, due to a requirement of the Kenyan government, the child must leave MMH. Most are offered admission to the John Kaheni Residence. The school sponsorship automatically becomes a vocational training sponsorship or university studies sponsorship. *Of note: Among the children at MMH there are a few who, due to learning difficulties, are unable to attend secondary school after the 9th grade. Instead, they undertake vocational training at a boarding school. They remain under the care of the MMH social workers and under our sponsorship.*

As every year, numerous activities were offered for the children during the long Christmas holidays – organized and supervised by the experienced trainers of the ChiCa (Children Care) team. The program began with active games such as rope skipping, speed stacking and rollerblading. This was followed by a diverse craft program that included knitting and crocheting as well as making bracelets from beads and buttons. In addition, various workshops were offered:

Creative Writing, Exploring Our Planet Through Art, and one specifically for MMH school graduates entitled “My Future, My Path”. The woodworking shop was once again a popular spot where children built, repaired and worked creatively. Overall, the holidays offered a varied program that was enthusiastically received by the children.
