Thank you for worshiping with us this morning. Our church leadership continues to monitor COVID case levels and to adjust our guidelines, based on the recent CDC recommendations for indoor gatherings:

Masks are optional for those who are fully vaccinated, however encouraged for those who desire extra protection.

Social Distancing The side aisles of the church are reserved for those who desire social-distancing.

Communion bread and wine will be offered by intinction; the clergy will place the wafer in your hand, and if you choose to have wine, you can dip the wafer in the chalice provided by the Lay Eucharistic Minister. If you prefer communion be brought to you in your pew, please remain seated and let the usher know.

We will continue to livestream worship on YouTube for our online community. We hope that by offering an option for online worship, those who are not ready to come to church will feel connected.

Children's Chapel meets at 10:00 a.m. in the Parish Hall. Masks are optional.

Nursery care is available in the Parish Hall. Your infants and toddlers are welcome to stay in the nursery during the church service. The nursery is a COVID-safe environment.
