If you wish to utilize the services of Serendipity Club at the Pre-paid, Drop-In, or Family rate, you must complete both sides of this form and attach your registration fee payment of \$85.00. Checks only please payable to Serendipity Club.

Serendipity Club service is available for Pre-Kindergarten students.

### Registration Fee

Registration is a start-up fee for the program. It permits the Director to purchase supplies and materials that are necessary to administer the program. The registration fee is \$85.00 per family each year.

### Pre-paid Rate

Families who **PAY THE REGISTRATION FEE PRIOR** to using the Serendipity Club services and **PAY IN ADVANCE** will be charged at a rate of \$5.25 per hour/per child.

### Drop-In Rate

Families who **PAY THE REGISTRATION FEE PRIOR** to using the Serendipity Club services and **DO NOT PAY IN ADVANCE** will be charged at a rate of \$6.25 per hour/per child.

### Non-Registered Rate

Families who **DO NOT PAY THE REGISTRATION FEE PRIOR** to using the Serendipity Club services will be charged at a rate of \$7.45 per hour/per child.

### Family Rate

To alleviate the burden and economic hardship pertaining to childcare costs experienced by families with two (2) or more children, the Serendipity Club has set up a tiered rate schedule of charges. Families who have **PAID THE REGISTRATION FEE PRIOR** to using the Serendipity Club services and **PAY IN ADVANCE** will be charged at a rate of \$5.25 per hour for the sibling with the most hours, with additional siblings charged at a rate of \$5.05 per hour/per child. For equal amounts of hours, one (1) sibling will be charged at a rate of \$5.25 per hour, with additional siblings charged at a rate of \$5.05 per hour/per child. **Families must be registered prior to using the Serendipity Club services and pay in advance to be charged this rate.**

### Rates After 6:00 PM

Serendipity is an extra service that is provided by the school to our families. After 6:00 PM, families will be charged at a rate of **\$1.00 per minute/per child for the first ten (10) minutes, and \$20.00 per hour/per child, or fraction thereof, thereafter.** These "Late Pick-Up Fees" are due and payable at the time of pick-up. If a family is unable to pick up their child by 6:00 PM, their continued use of Serendipity Club services will be in jeopardy.

### FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

I agree to pay according to the guidelines of the Extended Care Handbook for services rendered by the Serendipity Club of Holy Rosary School. **"Late Pick-Up Fees"** are as follows: **Serendipity Club closes at 6:00 PM.** Parents/Guardians are expected to arrive no later than 6:00 PM. **There is no grace period after 6:00 PM.** Parents/Guardians will be charged at a rate of **\$1.00 per minute/per child for the first ten (10) minutes, and \$20.00 per hour/per child, or fraction thereof, thereafter.** These "Late Pick-Up Fees" are due and payable at the time of pick up. If a family is unable to pick up their child by 6:00 PM, their continued use of Serendipity Club services will be in jeopardy.

Serendipity Club is a self-contained program. It relies on timely payments to cover the operating costs. **Failure to keep your account current will result in termination of before and after school care services.** Any outstanding balances that are 30 days past due will be transferred to your tuition account.

## GUIDELINES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

### A. **General Policy**

1. All medication to be given to students must be authorized by a parent/legal guardian.
2. All prescription medication, aspirin or pain reliever requires a physician's and parent/legal guardian authorization.
3. No student shall be given medication during school hours without a written request from the physician responsible for the medical management of student and parent/legal guardian.

### B. **Responsibility of the Parents/Legal Guardians**

1. Parent/Legal Guardian shall obtain **Request for Medication Form** (Appendix 6009A) as needed at the school office. If you are bringing in more than one medication, then you'll need to obtain several forms. It is required that a **separate request form** be submitted for each medication. Additional forms available at the school office.
2. Parent/Legal Guardian will assume full responsibility for the supplying of all medication.
3. No medication may be brought to school by the student.
4. Parent/Legal Guardian shall deliver or cause to be delivered by an adult or an authorized employee of a pharmaceutical supplier, any medication to be administered under the provision of this policy.
5. Parent/Legal Guardian shall pick up all medication at the end of the school year or it will be disposed.
6. Parent/Legal Guardian shall renew **Request for Medication Form** (Appendix 6009A) and re-supply medication each year.

### C. **Responsibility of the Physician**

1. A separate **Request for Medication Form** (Appendix 6009A) for each prescribed medication must be completed and signed by the student's physician, signed by the parent/legal guardian, and filed with the school administrator or his/her designated representative.
2. **THE CONTAINER MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION**
  - student's full name
  - physician's name
  - physician's telephone number
  - name of medication
  - dosage and frequency of medication
  - date of expiration of the prescription
3. Each medication is to be in a separate container labeled as above.

### D. **Responsibility of School Personnel**

1. Students taking medication will be assisted by authorized school personnel. This shall be done in accordance with the physician's instruction.
2. All medication administered by school personnel must be kept locked in a secured place under appropriate temperature conditions.

### E. **ASPIRIN AND OTHER OVER-THE-COUNTER DRUGS**

1. The dispensing of aspirin or pain reliever will be treated as a prescription drug. No aspirin or pain reliever will be administered to students by any school personnel without written authorization from the student's physician.
2. Students requiring over-the-counter drugs (with the exception of aspirin or pain reliever) will be assisted by authorized school personnel. This should be done in accordance with the parent's/legal guardian's instruction provided a signed request form (Appendix 6009A) is on file for the specified medication and all items listed above in B,C(2) and C(3) have been complied with.
3. A physician's authorization is advised but not required for over-the-counter medication (with the exception of aspirin or pain reliever).

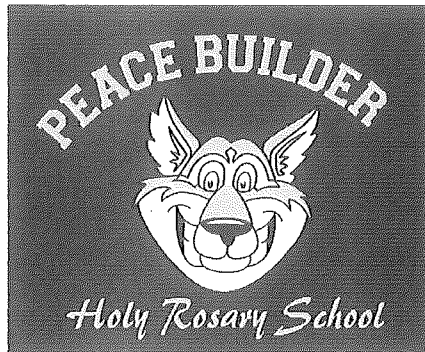

I understand the nature of this class involves the instructor to use her qualified judgment, when casting characters. Private Auditions will be held Tuesday, August 28, 2018, and will consist of singing a selected song from "Disney's The Little Mermaid, Jr." and reading a prepared monologue for each character of your child's choice (a minimum of 2 characters and up to 3 characters). Audition materials will be emailed once pre-registration has been completed on Thurs., August 2, 2018 and Friday evening, August 24, 2018 for all those who did not pre-register. I realize not all participants are able to have a lead role; however, I understand my child will be cast in the production and acknowledge that each character is vitally important to the overall production. And I accept and support the director's decisions concerning casting.

I understand if my child is disruptive or disrespectful, the instructor may excuse him/her short-term or permanently with written or verbal notification. I understand this is a September thru January class, with performances Saturday & Sunday, January 19-20, 2019 at El Campanil Theatre in Antioch. I will make every attempt to have my child attend all practices. The weekly rehearsal will be from 3:00-5:00PM (and January rehearsals will be till 5:30PM; half days class will be 12noon-2:00pm) and will involve specific characters/groups staying until 5:30pm (or 2:30pm on half days. This allows for the necessary minimum 36+ hours of rehearsal time. If I know my child will not be at a rehearsal, I will contact the instructor in advance by phone or by email.

The Non-Refundable monthly tuition is \$80.00 per month for September thru January. The \$150 Registration Fee covers Licensing and Royalties of the Broadway Junior musical, 1 Rehearsal MP4 clips emailed, theater rental deposit, props, sets, printing and other supplies and NECESSARY costumes will be provided (all students will need a basic black base costume that parents will need to provide...Info sent after auditions). The Pre-Registration Fee of \$150 is due no later than Wed., August 1, 2018 or the Registration Fee of \$150 is due Friday, Aug. 24, 2018 at 2pm. ## In the News:

### DRAMA STUDENTS OUTPERFORM NON-ARTS PEERS ON SAT TESTS

The College Entrance Examination Board reported student scores from 2001, 2002, 2004, and 2005 using data from the Student Description Questionnaire indicating student involvement in various activities, including the arts. As compared to their peers with no arts coursework or involvement:

Students involved in drama performance scored an average of 65.5 points higher on the verbal component and 35.5 points higher in the math component of the SAT

Students who took courses in drama study or appreciation scored, on average, 55 points higher on verbal and 26 points higher on math than their non-arts classmates.

In 2005, students involved in drama performance outscored the national average SAT score by 35 points on the verbal portion and 24 points on the math section.

## DRAMA IMPROVES

### ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

Numerous studies have demonstrated a correlation between drama involvement and academic achievement. In addition to having higher standardized test scores than their peers who do not experience the arts, student who participate in drama often experience improved reading comprehension, maintain better attendance records, and stay generally more engaged in school than their non-arts counterparts. Schools with arts-integrated programs, even in low-income areas, report high academic achievement.

### Scholarship Info:

\*\*\*All students who participate in an after school program hosted at Holy Rosary School are under the guidelines of the HRS Serendipity Extended Care Club. You do not need to be registered at Serendipity to attend Musical Theater. An extended care fee of \$25.00 is included in your fees to cover your time on campus with Musical Theater. This fee will be paid to Holy Rosary School by the instructor. If your child stays after class, regular Serendipity rates will apply for that time period.



## Grades 2-3 Musical Theater in Dominican Hall

Grades 2-3 are invited to participate in the class. (2nd Graders—there are only 4 limited spots for ensemble numbers). Musical Theater will be held on Tuesdays (at the specified times on the front of the brochure...in Dominican Hall). The Registration Fee will be a cost of \$150.00, per child enrolled. The Non-Refundable Tuition is divided over the 5 months of September-January to make the class more feasible at \$80/month (rather than a large sum of \$400.00) is due in addition to the Registration Fee. The Registration Fee covers licensing and royalties for the showkit from Broadway Junior, program printing, technical assistants, libretto books, MP4 links for rehearsal music, props, and printing supplies and additional necessary materials. ALL NEEDED COSTUMES WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THIS PRODUCTION, BUT ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED A BLACK BASE COSTUME. Each student is responsible for the Ben Nye Stage Makeup Kit (\$19.50), and Shoes for the production. The Registration Fee of \$150 secures your child's place in this program. Then, monthly tuition of \$80 for September through January should be paid in the form of post-dated checks for the 1st day of each month for \$80/month (5 months, 5 Post-dated checks or Zelle or Venmo may be sent for those wishing to pay in full and receive a \$25 discount for a total of \$525.00). The class roster is filled on a "First-Come, First-Served" basis. There are LIMITED SPOTS available!

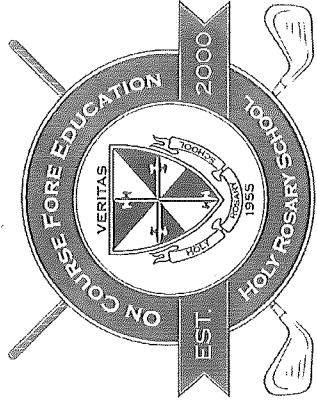

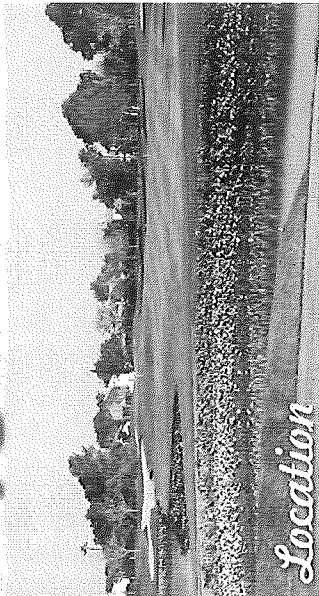

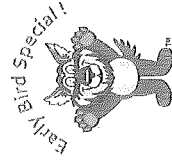
