egg hunt to follow



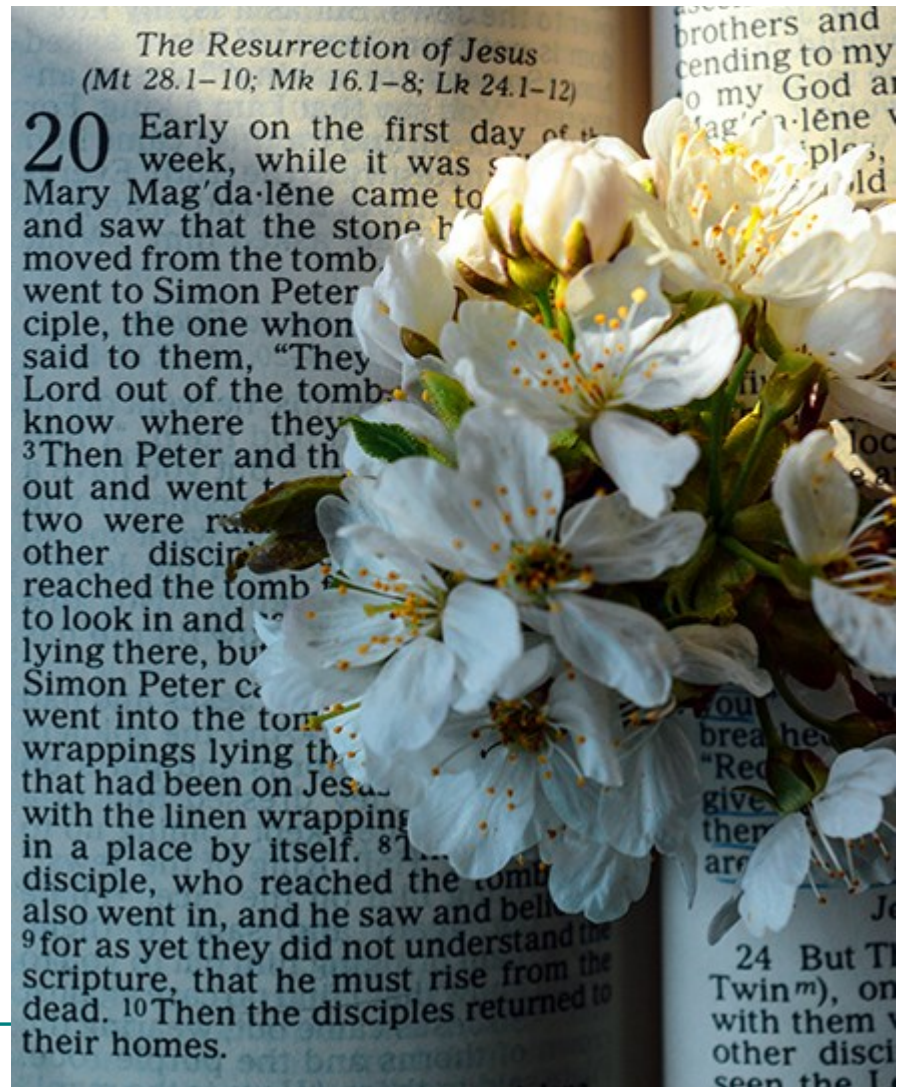


The Living Hope:
