Sandwich bags that zip closed (Gallon, Sandwich and quart)

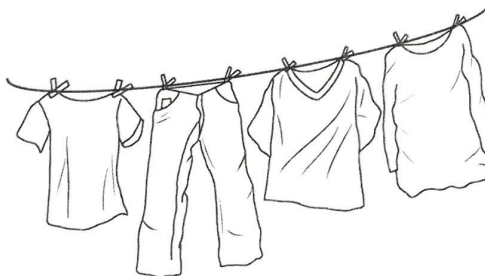
