God bless you! Welcome to worship! We worship in person Sundays at 8:30 & 11 am and live stream worship online at 11 am. See our website peacelutherantacoma.org, Facebook page (Facebook Peace Lutheran Tacoma), or YouTube channel for worship videos and faith resources.

It is a blessing to worship in person. Masks are welcome and encouraged but not required. We continue to require masks the first Sunday of each month for 8:30 am worship so those who need to take additional precautions can participate. If you are experiencing symptoms of illness, please stay home and worship online.

Today is **Palm/Passion Sunday**, first day of Holy Week. The Gospels tell the story of Jesus' entry into the royal city of Jerusalem as a humble king, sitting on a donkey, while the crowd places coats and branches on his path. Our tradition is to wave palm branches, shout "Hosanna," sing, and process into the sanctuary. Inside, the mood changes from celebration to somberness as we remember the story of Jesus' suffering and death, the "passion" of our Lord, a story of God's deep love.

Today we wave **Eco-Palms** in partnership with Lutheran World Relief, helping palm harvesters in Latin America, their families and communities find pathways out of economic poverty. Fair prices for palms encourage sustainable income for the harvesting community. Thanks be to God!

Prayer ministers are available to pray one on one with individuals during Holy Communion and after worship.

Families with children: During 11 am worship, we offer a children's worship time in the basement classroom. We post Godly Play videos on our YouTube channel to use at home.
