Specifically –

- Fully fund WIC (Women Infants and Children) Supplemental Nutrition Program, so that more families in the US can enroll and stay enrolled
- Restore, secure, and protect robust funding for global nutrition programs. These programs are lifesaving for millions of children, and we must restore them.

Other points:

- Total cost of WIC and global nutrition programs combined are much less than 1% of the Federal Budget.
- They save and improve the lives of many millions of children.
- They are effective soft power, building America's standing as a leader and trusted partner.
