It is a blessing to worship in person. Based on community risk levels for COVID, flu, and RSV, we are requiring masks during worship. For other church activities, including the Faith Education Hour, masks are recommended. If you are experiencing symptoms of illness, please stay home and worship online. Please be respectful of those who wish to limit physical contact (hugs/handshakes). We continue to increase airflow in the sanctuary during worship to reduce risk. We encourage all to get a flu shot and COVID booster.

We are now in the church season of Epiphany, meaning “a revealing,” and we’re keeping our eyes open to the ways God is revealed in our lives. Light and mission are Epiphany themes. In the Gospel Jesus teaches his disciples in the Sermon on the Mount. He shares the beatitudes about those blessed by God.

Families with children: During 11 am worship, we offer a children’s worship time in the basement classroom. We post Godly Play videos on our YouTube channel to use at home.
