Tacoma Civil Rights Project Video

This video examines racism in Tacoma in the 20th century, through the eyes of elders in the Tacoma civil rights movement, with a focus on housing and employment discrimination. Although the video is about historic events, its stories connect closely with current events. We used this 50-minute video with our youth as part of the Loyal to the Local youth service and education week, and it generated a lot of interest and discussion among our young people.

- 3. What connections do you see between the historic civil rights struggles in Tacoma, and the Black Lives Matter movement today?
