



Q1 Does your office require medical records (if available) for new patients transferring to your office from another pediatrician?




Q4 Do you require that records be received prior to scheduling the first visit?


Q5 If you answered no, do you cancel new patient appointments if records have not been received prior to the visit?


Q6 Do you request the reason a patient is transferring to your office?

Answered: 112 Skipped: 2




Q7 Do you share any office policies to be sure they are a good fit for your office? (Example: vaccines)
