Telemedicine

- The DEA is working on finalizing the proposed rules of the Special Registration for Telemedicine.
- As it reads now, it is defined as an "in-person evaluation" and isn't clear if subsequent visits may be telemedicine.
- Prescriptions for controlled substances were allowed via TM, but in person will be required after 5/11/2023. (Depending on interpretation)
- The AAP will be holding a webinar 3/13 on Telemedicine for any of you that are AAP members

Telemedicine, continued

- Due to the pandemic, all states waived some aspects of state licensure such that you could provide TM to a patient out of state.
- Some states tied this waiver to the end of the pandemic. If this is true for GA, you may no longer provide TM to a child out of state as of 5/11/2023(depending on commercial insurance policies).
- Medicaid patients may have a longer access period depending what is determined by Federal and State.
- Awaiting clarification from GA AAP

Telemedicine, continued

- While TM was supposed to pay the same as an in person visit, some offices have seen lower payments on these claims
- This may be due to the high % of self funded plans or non ACA plans in GA. In these cases these parity rules don't have to be followed.

Medicaid Unwinding

- On 4/1/2023, GA must redetermine eligibility for all Medicaid or PeachCare for Kids enrollees.
- There is a 14 month window to conduct redetermination. All redeterminations, eligibility, disenrollments and appeals must be completed by 05/31/2024.

COVID Vaccines

- As long as the supply lasts, federal government will supply vaccines to practices at no cost.
- Cannot charge patient/insurance for this vaccine.
- Even after federal supply is gone will likely still be covered by most insurance.
- Issue will become presentation of vaccine (practice purchases 10 dose vials and wastes doses).



PCR/Rapid COVID tests in the medical office

- While most patients may still have coverage for these tests, the cost associated with the test may be subject to cost sharing (deductible, out of pocket).
- Medicaid/CHIP patients will have free testing through 09/2024.





Pfizer Covid Vaccine Update

- Pfizer testing and distributing single dose vials (for 12 years +) in rural areas
 - NDC # will change once they are commercialized.
- Pfizer is prepping for the vaccine to be commercialized and adding to existing PBG contracts.
 - TCCN has this and will be contacted when Pfizer is ready
- No timelines yet for commercialization of vaccine

- Amendment Signed!!!!
 - Required signing Medicaid LOI & roster
- Tentatively Effective March 15, 2023
- 1% current year increase
- 3% fixed increase 3/15/2024 & 3/15/2025
- 2016 RBRVS

- Anthem
 - Commercial HMO, PPO, and Exchange base contract, plus EPHC valuebased agreement
- Amerigroup
 - Value-based agreement retroactively effective Jan. 1, 2022
- Cherokee County Employer Direct
- Quick Trip Employer Direct
- Northside Health Network (starting Jan. 1, 2023)
 - TCCN will be Tier 1 for Northside employees
- CareSource Medicaid base contract and value-based program
 - Signed for a retro-effective date of Jan. 1, 2023



CareSource Implementation



- Effective date: January 1/1/2023 (Retro)
- Implementation:
 - TCCN finalizing roster
 - 30 days load time from roster submission
 - Striving for seamless transition for practices

- includes the benchmarks for employee benefits.
- All of the data is broken out by years of experience and practice size.
- It is a valuable tool for management

Salary Survey Tips

- Survey is 2 parts Excel worksheet and Survey Monkey
- 2. Please be sure to include the total number of employees in each position as well as the highest hourly wage, lowest hourly wage, and averaged hourly wage for each position.
- 3. Please choose the position that the employee spends the primary amount of their time.
 - a. For example, a Medical Assistant who does lab procedures as part of their job would be listed as a full time MA. A Medical Assistant who spends their day in the lab, drawing blood, running lab procedures would be listed as a phlebotomist/Lab Assist
- 4. The years of service describes total # of years in that position/profession/field, not just years worked at your practice. The # of years/experience is used to justify the higher level of wages a person should receive for bringing that additional level of expertise to the position.
- 5. If you do not submit a Salary Survey for your practice, you will not receive the aggregate network data that is returned

Midlevel Credentialing Update

- Piloting the midlevel credentialing program to make sure process is complete before rolling out to whole network
- New midlevel database is almost in beta testing phase.
- There will be a credentialing fee designed to cover additional cost of this service. (Amount tbd)

Peach State Settlement Update

Settlements are in various stages of completion:

- 13 practices resolved. Settlement checks received
- 1 practice has a check processing/enroute
 - Payment should be received by end of February
- 3 practices accepted the settlement offer
 - PSHP has not provided the agreements for signature
- 4 practices in claims review
 - These practices have midlevel claims impact or other claim
 disputes
- PSHP running analytics and working through new settlement offers
