



Announcing the Georgia Pathways to Coverage Program

Georgia Pathways to Coverage Program is a new program that will give low-income Georgians who are working or preparing for work and are not eligible for Medicaid today a new opportunity to gain access to healthcare coverage through Medicaid.



- Georgia residents can apply for the program starting on July 1, 2023.
- Residents can apply for the program online, mail in a paper application, telephonically or In-person.
- Eligible members must be a Georgia resident and between the ages of 19 and 64.
- Individuals that are approved for the program, their coverage would start the first day of the following month after being approved.
- Pathways members are eligible to receive the same State Plan benefits as other Medicaid groups, with the exception of Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT).
- Pathways member ages 19 and 20 who are receiving EPSDT may access NEMT as part of their benefits.
- Individuals identified as eligible for Pathways will be auto assigned into a CMO using the State's existing assignment methodology.
- Certain criteria must be met in order to qualify for the Georgia Pathways Program.
- Members must complete 80 hours of qualifying activities per month.
