# What you will need for Financial Benchmarking

- Reports that include
  - Charges, Payments, Visits (new patient well and sick visits and established patient well and sick visits)
  - Charges, payments and visits from other types of providers (Lactation, Dietician- that are not provided and billed by an APP)
  - Physician and Staff average hours worked/FTE
  - Your practice aging by age bucket and by insurance
  - Expenses

# Corporate Transparency Act Update

- The Corporate Transparency Act (CTA) went into effect 1/1/2024.
- The Financial Crimes Network (FinCEN) was charged with enforcement of the Beneficial Ownership Information (BOI) reporting
- Any company created or registered to do business before 1/1/2024 will have until 01/01/2025 to file the initial report
- A Federal District Court ruled Friday 3/1/2024 that the CTA is unconstitutional. It is too early to know if the US government will appeal
- At this time, this ruling only affects a small number of the small businesses that are to comply with this law.
- As of the current FinCEN reading, medical offices do NOT meet the criteria for an exemption and are required to file a Beneficial Ownership Information report on the website.
