## INFORMATION & DETAILS

Trinity's Mexico Home Build partners with Homes of Hope, a ministry of YWAM (Youth with a Mission).

Homes of Hope ensures that every family who receives a home truly needs help, and that the home is not a handout, but a hand UP. Each family is required to make payments on their land, prepare the site and build alongside the group.

Over half the families in Mexico live below the poverty line. A debt-free home helps families so money and attention can be spent on food, medicine, school, clothes and shelter. A new home builds lives, strengthens marriages, keeps kids in school and helps families get ahead economically. More importantly, a home provides hope for a better future.

As we build with Trinity participants, Homes of Hope, and the family receiving the home, there is a wonderfully unique opportunity to share in what God is doing in Mexico and encourage each other in love.



## FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

The financial commitment has two parts - participant registration (transportation, lodging, and meals) AND fundraising for building materials.

### **PART 1:** TRANSPORTATION, LODGING, & MEALS

\$459 adult  
\$250 youth (20 & younger)

The YWAM compound where we stay is a gated sanctuary overlooking the Pacific Ocean. The participant fee includes; transportation both ways across the border, lodging, meals, and YWAM ministry support.

### **PART 2:** FUNDRAISING FOR BUILDING MATERIALS

\$350 per person

Each home costs roughly \$12,000 to build with approx 20 people on one team. Fundraising pays for concrete foundation, all the lumber, windows, roofing, tools, paint, furnishings (bunk-bed, table/chairs, refrigerator), and Homes of Hope crew leaders.

**OCTOBER 15** —————  
Half of your family's total fees for transportation, lodging, and meals due

**NOVEMBER 12** —————  
Remaining balance of transportation, lodging, and meals due

**DECEMBER 3** —————  
Fundraising portion due
