I have long suspected that generosity lives here in Penn Central Conference – now I know for sure!

Your generous financial gifts to the *Friends of Penn Central Conference* OCWM fundraising campaign exceeded the goal by 30%, for a total gift of **\$13,040** (vs. \$10,000 goal)! The Friends campaign ended on November 28, but gifts are still being received – thank you!

During my first year as Conference Minister, visits to about 60 congregations has afforded me an opportunity to hear your stories about generosity; over and above what you give as tithes and offering to support your local church:

- Members have donated gifts to pay for special church projects like steeple lighting
- Long time members, now deceased, have left sizable bequests to their beloved congregations to provide scholarships for youth and support church vitality initiatives
- · Your purchase of alternative gift certificates helped to fund a new pool at Hartman Center
- Members give generously to help local, national and international concerns

Collectively, over the past three months, congregations have donated over **\$76,000** to assist with national hurricane and disaster recovery efforts. To address local needs, some congregations have formed ecumenical co-ops.

Your collective financial gifts to OCWM tell an encouraging story, as well:

- 17% of churches have already given more in 2017 than 2016
- 29% of our churches that didn't give last year are giving this year
- only (7%), 14 churches, have not provided any OCWM support over the past 2 years

Although overall OCWM giving is only 81.4% of the budgeted goal through November, we are counting on a strong finish to the year. Therefore, year-end giving will be crucial – from both individuals and congregations. I believe the spirit of generosity that dwells in your heart will continue to overflow and bless those around you.

It is a privilege to serve alongside all of you. Thank you for investing in our continued ministry together in Penn Central Conference and the wider United Church of Christ!
