A Message from PCC

Dear Friends and Members of Penn Central Conference,

*For with you is the fountain of life;
in your light we see light.*

Psalm 36:9 (NRSV)

With God is the fountain of life. As I read this week's lectionary passages, this phrase just grabbed me by the heart. Life has felt a little more like a shallow tub most days over the past couple years. Even when we have glimpses of what life after the pandemic might look like, a fountain of life if you will, a new variant comes along that dramatically changes the moment and the vision.

There are moments of fountain life, exploring new natural spaces with my family, some worship experiences brought only because of the forced changes to our worship practices and even some zoom prayer meetings. But they have felt more like the moving fountains at the splash park, unpredictable, than like the fountain of life I remember in the before-times.

I don't think of myself as one who wants to return to life as it was, we have learned too much to do that, but I do long for the ever-flowing fountain of life I think I remember. How do we claim both?

In the mail this week I received a little book of "post-pandemic ponderments" from the UCC's StillSpeaking Writers Group. The national setting has mailed this out to all active authorized ministers in their database according to the enclosed letter. I love questions and the personal and collective journeys that search for answers so this little book was right up my alley. "What if?" the title asks.

I could hear clergy communities of practice seeking new understandings of call and pastoral identity in a new age. I pictured families gathered around the living room tv for church zoom game nights.

And in a flash, I was reminded that the fountain of life is with God and God is with us, even when I have to work to open myself to God's presence, God is with me. God is with you. And with God is the fountain of life. How will I see it today? How will you experience this fountain of life today? Tomorrow? How will your church?
