General Synod 33, July 11-18, 2021

This is a General Synod year in the United Church of Christ and there may never be a better time for your entire congregation to join the national setting for this event!! All parts of General Synod 33 will be online, just as so much of life has been lately. As I sit with this theme scripture, I think about these "they" and wonder how exactly I might "delight in the law of the Lord." Each time I think about it, I find myself wondering through scriptures that inform my living, hoping that the fruit I see is real.
