Workshop Description

Screens are ubiquitous in our lives, including in our sanctuaries. Screens open up many opportunities, but using them effectively is difficult. Good use can engage and expand your message, but a clunky, outdated, or overly-busy screen will distract the audience. If you're not sure how — or when — to use a screen during the sermon, you need this interactive series of workshops. We will look at the benefits and pitfalls of using a screen during prelude, worship, and preaching.

The Rev. Dr. Erin S. Cox-Holmes was raised in Redlands, California. The focus of her Doctor of Ministry degree (from Dubuque Theological Seminary) is on revitalizing the church and worship in the digital age. Erin is known as a computer geek and has been puzzling over the same e e cummings poem for 30 years.
