### Dear Friends and Members of Penn Central Conference,

*Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you." John 20:21a

limbering effect on the mind." William Sloane Coffin*

Fear was all around the disciples in the days following Christ's crucifixion and resurrection. Fear is still common among us today as the world sees war, hunger, homelessness, illness, plain ol' ill, and so much more running rampant in so many places. It is interesting to me how in the face of very real fear among the disciples, Jesus did not come to them in their locked room and offer safety and security, he gave peace and presence through the Holy Spirit - Peace to still their hearts and minds and invite them to think more clearly in the face of fear, a Presence to be with them always.

There is indeed plenty to be fearful of in our world today. Fear, though, is a distraction from our calling to share Christ and love one another.
