

Pilgrimage to Peace

Lancaster is the first stop in the *Pilgrimage to Peace*, a one-week speaking tour given by the national consortium Churches for Middle East Peace. This interfaith dialog focuses on work being done in Palestine, Israel, and the United States to help achieve peace and justice in the Holy Land. Learn of these efforts as we work together to better understand the realities affecting both Israelis and Palestinians and how people of faith in the United States can play a positive role in pursuing peace.

Speakers are the Rev. Dr. Mae Elise Cannon, executive director of Churches for Middle East Peace, Washington, DC; Rabbi Dr. Daniel Roth, director of the Pardes Center for Judaism and Conflict Resolution, Jerusalem; and Aziz Abu Sarah, a Palestinian Muslim businessman.
