In four months, we will celebrate Christmas!

Like many churches, both local and across the nation, we have had a traditional Candlelight Service on Christmas Eve for many decades. When it became necessary for us to replace the plastic candle holders, we couldn't find suitable replacements. We purchased a small quantity of the candle holder pictured below, but found that the 2 ¼" tapered handle was just too small to grasp.



We approached a local business, Covington Plastic Molding, 10 South Bolton Street, New Oxford, PA 17350 which specializes in plastic injection molding. We met with Scott and James and gave them a description of what we envisioned.

They provided us with a high-quality design that exceeded our expectations. Small hands and large hands alike find these candle holders much more comfortable to hold without the risk of slippage or tilt. The material is a stronger clear plastic with a 3 3/8" handle and less taper and it's washable for multiple uses.
