A Message from PCC

Dear Friends and Members of Penn Central Conference,

Last summer Psalm 1:3 was the theme scripture for General Synod and I walked with that psalm all summer and into the fall. It was life-giving in a season that needed life for me. As I began preparing for today's writing, I was excited to be greeted by this psalm as the lectionary psalm for this Sunday. It was again life-giving for me. Read these verses:

"Happy are those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or take the path that sinners tread, or sit in the seat of scoffers; but their delight is in the law of the LORD, and on God's law they meditate day and night. They are like trees planted by streams of water, which yield their fruit in its season, and their leaves do not wither. In all that they do, they prosper. The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish."

If, indeed, we can find ourselves delighting in God's Word, meditating on it day and night we are in a position to be continually nourished like a tree planted by streams of water. Just think about the ways in which a tree planted by a stream of water is able to sink its roots deep and drink of the nourishing water whenever that might be needed. It's exactly what happened to me this morning when Paul said, "Nora, you have the epistle today." And my heart sank as it was only about 2 hours before Paul would push send to you lovely readers. But alas, nourished by God's Word I was in reading this psalm. The weight of the morning lifted and a new day dawned (at 11:59am).


