The Board of Directors met this past Saturday, and we are glad to update the conference on the major actions and decisions made by your board. Here are the highlights:

1. Our conference staff, under the leadership of **Rev. Dr. Carrie Call**, continue to remain busy despite meeting and travel restrictions. They remain in regular contact with and offer spiritual support and guidance to our local churches on many issues. A weekly calendar shares all the group meetings that are held to keep us in covenant with one another. There are weekly lectionary discussions, church empowerment teams, Poetry as Prayer group meetings, and staff continue to attend Ministerium and Association meetings. **Rev. churches in various phases of the search and call process and supporting the Congregational Empowerment Academy. If your church needs search and call or has other transition needs, please reach out to her. **Rev. Dr. Ronnette Comfort-Butler** is recruiting and training our chaplains and staying in touch with clergy with a focus on how pastors make changes and deal with a year of change. She can provide support to clergy on many issues, so please do not hesitate to reach out to her. **Mr. Paul Keller** is busy with communications and the Data-Hub, as well as coordinating numerous ZOOM meetings for the conference and our associations. **Ms. Anne Rankin** has been providing outreach for Outdoor Ministry, keeping us updated on the upcoming summer camp programs and enticing us with new ministry opportunities. Associations and churches are encouraged to have Ms. Rankin present these new opportunities at upcoming meetings.

2. The board reviewed the NEW draft Strategic Plan which outlines the direction for the board and conference over the next 3 years. It does not include a merging of associations, as per our previous plan. We approved changes to the Bylaws and a meeting will be held before the June annual meeting to review the changes and ask questions. The personnel policies are near completion, and the board will review. A format and procedure for annual staff evaluations is underway.

3. The finance committee shared that we are operating at a loss of \$45,000 according to the February financials. The committee will be providing a detailed financial overview at our "Special" April budget meeting. Reports have been reformatted and new reports designed to assist the board in careful review of the conference's financial statements have been finalized.

4. Hartman Center: The Hartman Center Sales Committee receives monthly updates from the realty company. The listing has received interest, inquiry, and visitation in the last several months. One offer has been made.

5. The Sale of St. John's Lebanon – The closing of this church, while sad, has created new opportunities. The board is discussing that the proceeds from the sale be provided back to the Lebanon community, providing microgrants for community-serving organizations.

6. Outdoor Ministry/Summer Camping: The board approved that money from the current endowment investment accounts be used to provide support for the 2021

summer camp enrollment. Guidelines will be established for the use of this money. Members of the board have attended some of the events at Kirkenwald, Nawakwa, and The Wittel Farm. In fact, learning that a Medical Director was needed, Dr. Janis Taylor, a member of our board, agreed to serve in this capacity. We so appreciate her willingness to fill this need and to know that the medical needs of our campers will continue at a high standard.

7. Possible Office Relocation: The current conference space has been long underutilized and inefficient for conference needs. Alternate space is being considering keeping mind location, accessibility, and changes in work needs. We have an amazing staff and board of directors. We understand the gift we have in our conference and know the responsibilities that we have been given as your Board of Directors. Thank you for supporting and praying for us as we do the work of the Conference!
