Moses said to them, "It is the bread that the LORD has given you to eat." (Ex 16:15b, read 16:1-15)

This scripture along with the Lord's Prayer and other passages point us toward a daily practice of not just being with God as we always are, but toward an intentional acknowledgement of God's presence among us, even our gratitude for it and so much more.

I have a bit of a confession to share with you all today. This passage stopped me in my tracks Monday as I began sermon preparation for this week. 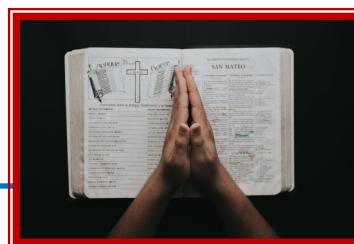
