We are conducting a sample collection study to help develop and validate an investigational non-invasive prenatal genetic screening test. Participation involves collecting blood and/or potentially cheek swab samples and health information from both the biological female parent who has screened positive as a carrier and their biological child.

The investigational test is being developed to be used during pregnancy for people who are carriers of certain genetic conditions who want to help determine whether their unborn baby may have inherited a genetic condition. Biological Female Parent

- You must reside in the United States
- You are 18 years or older
- You have screened positive as a carrier for one or more inherited genetic conditions
- You are able and willing to sign informed consent

Biological Child

- You must reside in the United States
- For children who are 17 years or younger:
 - You are able and willing to provide assent, when applicable
 - You weigh 10 kg (22 lbs) or higher if a blood sample is collected
