

The chalice is from *Heildersheim Germany*, made in 1856. He purchased it from an antique shop in West End, NJ during his Diaconate retreat in 1972. After he purchased it, it needed to be refurbished. *Louis Hupfled, Baltimore, MD* did this. It is mounted as seen above with a knod (to hold it) and highlighted with his mother Rose's wedding band and engagement diamond. Later a cousin on his mother's side of the family gave him the 14 Ct. amethyst on the base. The cup is hand-chased with olive branches, reminiscent of his Sicilian family heritage. This family heirloom came into weekly celebratory use at each Mass Fr. Louis celebrated from home. It had a special significance...and memories.
