The Rhode Island Department of Education (RIDE), in collaboration with the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH), is pleased to announce that we are now offering participation in a one-time COVID-19 testing program at Gaudet Middle School and Learning Academy. Rhode Island continues to pursue aggressive testing for COVID-19 as a foundation of addressing the pandemic in the state. As part of the state testing approach, we are now testing in schools.

Gaudet Middle School and Learning Academy will offer polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests on **Thursday, April 29**. All students, staff, and teachers at schools are being offered testing at this site free of charge.

For the test, your student will receive one nasal swab. This swab will be sent to a lab for PCR-based testing. The results of this test will be available in 24-48 hours on [portal.ri.gov](https://portal.ri.gov). The school nurse, Mrs. Nina Phillips, will have access to the results of the PCR test.
