Mississippi River 5-mile Canoe or Kayak Trip:

Enjoy a 5-mile, group float/paddle trip from Island View Park to Clearwater, MN. This is a beginner friendly, flatwater paddling experience with no classed rapids. Typically a 1-2 hour paddle in July, with shoreline and sandbars to stop, stretch, enjoy a snack, throw a ball, hunt for agates, etc. Prior to your trip you will receive a map session, and short safety video before getting issued lifejackets and paddles, then hopping on the shuttle to your starting point. *You must be registered for the full, 4-day AG to take advantage of this trip!
