

Talbot School of Theology
Seminary Partnership with the CCCC



Goal – to develop a cohort of 25 students (men and women) who will participate in a master’s level study to prepare for ministry.

We are recruiting students for an inaugural cohort to study at a world-class and Christ-centered seminary. The partnership offers a 50% scholarship to distinctive and distinguished students who will be a part of this inaugural cohort. Scholarships are also available through the CCCC. The cost of the program is \$28,835 for the M.Div. program and \$17,885 for the M.A. program. The cohort will begin study in the Fall semester of 2026.

Talbot Embedded is a cohort-based pathway within the [Master of Arts in Christian Ministry and Leadership \(Ministry & Leadership\)](#) and [Master of Divinity \(Pastoral and General Ministries\)](#) programs. Designed for active ministry leaders, it offers the depth of Talbot’s theological training within a community of peers walking the same journey. Each semester combines online coursework with a three-day, in-person gathering in location selected by the CCCC, creating a rhythm of learning that is both flexible and deeply relational.
