



What Is the LAP Stewardship Plan?

The **LAP Stewardship Plan** is a simple, memorable framework for encouraging faithful Christian generosity throughout the CCCC. Inspired by Jesus' words in Luke 6:38—"Give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap."

LAP organizes stewardship around three complementary areas:

1. Legacy Giving

- a. Legacy churches
- b. Estate plans of individuals

2. Active Giving

- a. Pastors
- b. Churches
- c. Grants

3. Passive Giving

- a. Investment Income

Legacy Giving looks to the future by encouraging individuals and churches to consider how the resources God has entrusted to them can continue supporting gospel ministry for generations. **Active Giving** puts resources to work today by strengthening pastors, churches, and ministry grants. **Passive Giving** seeks to steward existing assets wisely so that investment income can provide sustainable support for ministry over time.

LAP is not intended to reinvent Christian stewardship. Rather, it gives familiar and time-tested principles a clear structure and common language. Its larger purpose is to cultivate a culture of generosity across the CCCC—helping Christians see stewardship not merely as meeting financial needs, but as the joyful privilege of using God-given resources for Kingdom purposes that can extend far beyond our own lifetimes.
