Principal Search

Our search committee interviewed several candidates from January 2022 through March 2022, offering the position to one who accepted then withdrew for personal reasons. Because our administrative team, teaching staff, and non-teaching staff continue to work well together moving MCC forward, we will maintain our current structure for the 2022-23 school year and reboot our principal search process in September 2022.

Staff Changes

Two teachers will leave us at year's end – Mrs. Christi Head from our science department and Dr. Audison Beaubrun from our math department. Additionally, Mrs. Rita Herschbach from our English Department will move to part time in 2022-23. The last day for our Admissions Director Mrs. Ann Kasch will be May 13, 2022.
