The Board has agreed to initiate an effort to improve presentations at outdoor shows. Objectives are to eliminate clutter and unprofessional appearances, create more uniformity, increase safety and stability, and enforce rules including strict adherence to attendance and cancelation policies preventing unsightly gaps and setup confusion.

In order to achieve these objectives and as done with outdoor shows produced by other organizations, all (new and existing exhibitors) outdoor show participants are asked to submit an image of their displays for evaluation and for suggested and or required changes. Participation in shows will not be granted unless the image has been reviewed and approved. Submission of images in JPG format should be sent/emailed to Gay Williamson, Linda Greenwald and or Bruce Bain. Additionally, members of the outdoor show committee will during show season continuously review displays making suggestions to maintain standards.

A copy of the outdoor show rules/guidelines is available on the DAL website. A copy is also attached. As failure to maintain rules/guidelines and appearnace will result in suspension from shows, it is strongly suggested you review requirements. For exhibitors who are unsure of or need assistance with arranging their displays, outdoor show committee representatives will be available prior to monthly meetings.
