



Painting Florals in Watercolors

*This class will teach the methods for painting three beautiful flowers, using the inherent qualities of the watercolor medium. Watercolor is fluid by nature and capturing the image of a sunflower, a rose or the hibiscus in a loose and exciting manner, is a way that watercolors can be applied which is one objective of the program. Students can select one or all three flowers to study and paint, using actual flowers (**not a photo**) as the subject. The class will study the basic elements of each flower and towards the end of the six week program, students can attempt to paint a bouquet using the image of one or all three flowers within the composition.*

The program is six weeks in duration, each weekly class being two hours long. The primary goal is to complete a painting based on each student's own composition and selection of flowers; concentrating on form and color.

*This is an **intermediate level class** and will require a specific list of materials and supplies (a list will be available with a more detailed description of the program). A limited palette will be used.*

The Thursday night class (6:00PM-8:00pm) begins March 22nd and will end April 26th, 2018. All classes will be held at 342 NE 1st St., Delray Beach.

Program cost: \$240.00
