

Outagamie County Family Find Program Outcomes

Outcome summary:

A total of 69 children achieved permanency during the first 3 quarters of 2020. Children placed with relatives achieved permanency **37% sooner** (10 months) than children placed with non-relatives.

Average months in care with relative/like kin- 22.1 months

- 2 children achieved permanency with a relative through a conservatorship are calculated with the relative caregiver outcomes.

Average months in care with non-relatives- 32.1 months

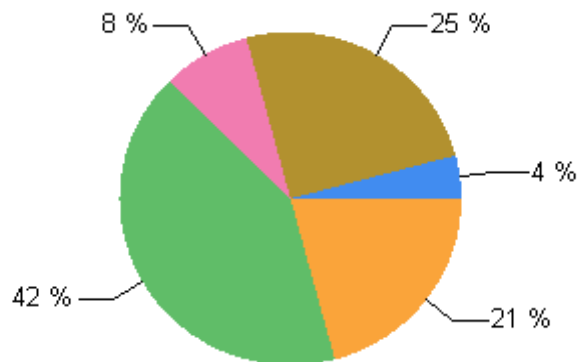

Outagamie County Family Find Outcomes Report- Living Situation

A total of 24 children were served and discharged from the Family Find Program during the 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarter of 2020. Of these children, 75% of them returned home or went to reside with a relative or like kin provider.
