3. Advertise, organize supplies, and make travel arrangements to complete your project.
4. At the end of each day, type 3-4 sentences in the [Journal Questions](#) doc (link in Google Classroom) and track how much money you spent and earned on the [Money Tracker](#) (link in Google Classroom).
5. Complete a [Google Slide presentation](#) (link in Google Classroom) about your summer project. Directions are on slide 2.
6. If you raise money as part of your business, please choose a charity or organization to which you will donate your profit or partial profit. Ask your grown-up to help you mail or deliver your donation when your project is complete.
7. Your work will be saved in your Google Classroom and will be at school when you arrive!
