



## Lower School Supplies List 2025-2026

### All Students Bring to School:

- Reusable water bottle labeled with name
- Backpack or tote bag to transport school materials
- Raincoat for rainy days (but please, no umbrellas!)
- Winter gear: winter coat, snow pants, boots, mittens or gloves, hat for winter days
- For Friday afternoons: Any students who attend Extended Day should bring a ready-to-eat lunch

*Please label ALL outerwear and gear, coats, sweatshirts and sweaters, with your child's name.*

### Pre-K Students

#### Bring to School:

- Extra set of labeled clothes (including underwear, socks, pants/shorts, shirt) in a labeled Ziploc bag
- Daily ready-to-eat lunch (Mon. - Thurs.)
- Please make sure the backpack is large enough to easily carry a lunchbox and outdoor gear. We suggest a 24L size offered at many stores.

### Kindergarten Students

#### Bring to School:

- Extra set of labeled clothes (including underwear, socks, pants/shorts, shirt) in a labeled Ziploc bag
- Framed 5x7 family photo

### First Grade Students

#### Bring to School:

- Extra set of labeled clothes (including underwear, socks, pants/shorts, shirt) in a labeled Ziploc bag

### Second Grade Students

#### Bring to School:

- Extra set of labeled clothes (including underwear, socks, pants/shorts, shirt) in a labeled Ziploc bag
- Two zippered vinyl pouches (size 10 ¾ x 14"): Available at the [Container Store](#) for \$3.99 each.  
**Please purchase at least two of these folders. Please use a black sharpie to write your child's first and last name on the outside of the folder.**

#### Required for study area at home:

- Pencils, pencil sharpener, erasers
- Crayons, glue sticks, highlighter, scissors
- Dice, ruler, paperclips
- Paper: plain white paper and lined paper (notebook is fine)

## Third Grade Students

### Bring to School:

- One zippered vinyl pouch (size 10 ¾ x 14"): Available at the [Container Store](#) for \$3.99 each.  
**Please purchase at least two of these folders, one spare in case it's needed. Please write your child's first and last name on the pouch.**

### Required for study area at home:

- Intermediate level dictionary such as: [The American Heritage Student Dictionary](#)
- Pencils, pencil sharpener, erasers, ruler
- Wide-ruled, white lined paper, white plain, unlined paper
- Stapler, markers, crayons, colored pencils, highlighter, glue sticks, paperclips, scissors
- Set of dice, deck of playing cards
- Flashcards for facts in all 4 operations- 0-12 addition, subtraction, multiplication, division ([sample set](#))

## Fourth Grade Students

### Bring to school:

- Pencil bag with mechanical or sharpened pencils. Throughout the year, this may need to be replenished.
- One zippered vinyl pouch (size 10 ¾ x 14"): Available at the [Container Store](#) for \$3.99 each.
- DCD will provide each student with an assignment book at the beginning of school.

### Required for study area at home:

- Intermediate level dictionary such as: [The American Heritage Student Dictionary](#) and thesaurus such as [The American Heritage Student Thesaurus](#) (or access to online dictionary and thesaurus)
- Pencils and erasers
- Colored pencils, glue, tape, ruler, scissors

## Fifth Grade Students

### Bring to school:

- Pencil bag and pencils. **No pencil boxes please.** Students are responsible for having a pencil at school every day throughout the year.

### Required for homework area at home:

- Pencils and erasers
- Colored pencils and/or markers
- Lined index cards, 3x5 or 4x6, any color
- Sticky/Post it Notes, 3x3
- Ruler, scissors, tape, stapler, glue stick
- Internet access and use of a computer, Chromebook, or iPad (ideally with an external keyboard). Printing capabilities are recommended and appreciated, but not required.
