







Uniform and Dress Code – Quick Family Reference

Shirt	<p>Polo: Short or long sleeve polo in white or navy with SPA crest.</p> <p>Oxford: Long sleeve white oxford pressed dress shirt with SPA crest (navy blazer with SPA approved tie optional).</p>	<p>Note: Shirts are always tucked in with waistband visible. Only top button of shirt undone. Must be in good repair and crest must be properly adhered to shirt.</p>	
Outerwear	<p>Sweaters: ¾ zip pullover, sweater or sweater vest in navy (all with SPA crest).</p> <p>Jacket: Under Armor warm up jacket with SPA crest.</p>	<p>Note: Only SPA outerwear permitted at school. Must wear a uniform shirt under outerwear. Must be in good repair and crest must be properly adhered to shirt.</p>	
Pants Shorts Skirts	<p>Dress Pants: Khaki in color with belt loops.</p> <p>Shorts: Khaki in color with belt loops.</p> <p>Skirt: Official SPA plaid skirt with hem at the top of the knee.</p> <p>Belt: Solid black/dark brown dress belt is required for pants and shorts.</p>	<p>Length: Pants must reach the shoe but not drag on the ground. Shorts must reach just above the knee. Pants/shirts must be worn at the waist. No undergarments are to be visible.</p> <p>Avoid: Khaki jeans, utility loops, patch pockets, extra zippers, Velcro, extra seams, oversized or “skinny” pants.</p>	
Footwear	<p>Shoes: White (only for 6th grade), dark brown or black leather or leather-like shoes. No cloth or canvas shoes.</p> <p>Heel: Dress shoe heel no more than 1.5 inches.</p> <p>Socks: White or solid black, navy or taupe in color and must be visible above the shoe. No logos.</p>	<p>Note: Shoes must be in good repair and free of writing. No-show socks prohibited.</p>	
Hair	<p>Style: Neatly combed, natural looking and conservative in color and cut. Hair may not change color during the school year.</p>	<p>Note for Boys: Off collar, above the eyebrows, above the midpoint of the ear.</p> <p>Note for girls: Neat small bows, barrettes, headbands, and hair ties permissible if they coordinate with the uniform and conservative in number.</p>	
Jewelry	<p>Note for Boys: One watch, one finger ring, and one necklace. Only simple, fine-gauged, 16–20-inch silver or gold chain necklace. Necklaces must be worn inside the shirt.</p> <p>Headwear: Hats, bandannas, and sunglasses are not permitted.</p>	<p>Note for girls:</p> <p>Makeup: Subtle makeup applied tastefully and in moderation.</p> <p>Nails: No garish or distracting colors or décor.</p> <p>Jewelry: One pair of earrings, one watch, one finger ring, one necklace with pendant no more than one inch in length and fine-gauge chain, and one bracelet.</p> <p>Earrings: No longer than one-half inch below the ear lobe. Worn in the earlobes only.</p>
