



Dear ACS and SPA Parents and Drivers,

While so many things are clearly going well this year, it is evident that traffic is not one of them. Those who are veterans of the Scottsdale schools know that this year has brought challenges heretofore unknown. Most of this is pure volume, but there are also behaviors that are increasing the difficulty and risk of our community.

In addition to being good stewards of public trust and education, we also have the responsibility of being good neighbors. There are behaviors that some drivers from ACS and SPA have engaged in that do not reflect the good will of our community and are actively harming our relationship with our neighbors on 92<sup>nd</sup> Street. The map below highlights some areas in red that are not public thoroughfares and must not be used for pick up, drop off, or transportation between the two Academies.



We ask that all drivers follow the normal drop off and pick up procedures shown in these maps each day. Carpooling, as well as arriving early and picking up late will help the situation, but short cuts through parking lots pose unnecessary risks for our students and long lasting conflicts with our neighbors.
