### Register for the PSAT!

All 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students will be taking the Preliminary SAT (PSAT) on Wednesday, October 16th, 2019. The PSAT provides important practice and can help students see where they can improve for future tests. For 11th grade students, the PSAT is also the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.
