Pants:

- No sweatpants, pajama bottoms, athletic or yoga pants, or leggings

Shirts:

- Spartan spirit-wear shirts or sweatshirts are acceptable
- Students may wear a non-logo, solid or print t-shirt, non-dress code sweater, polo or dress shirt
- All shirts must be modest, loose-fitting and in good condition (no holes or tears). No sleeveless shirts, midriffs, tank tops or camisoles

Shoes:

- Close-toe shoes (tennis shoes, casual shoes, flats or boots) are all acceptable
- No slippers, open-toed footwear or shoes with heels above 2”

Headwear:

- No hats, bandanas or sunglasses may be worn at school
