This comprehensive 50-hour program will prepare students to work as a pharmacy technician in a retail or other pharmacy setting and to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board's PTCB exam.

Course content includes:

- Pharmacy medical terminology;
- History of pharmacy;
- Pharmacy practice in multiple environments;
- Pharmacy calculations and measurements;
- Reading and interpreting prescriptions; and
- defining drugs by generic and brand names.

Through remote classroom lecture and hands-on activities, students will review dosage calculations, drug classifications, the top 200 drugs, I.V. flow rates, sterile compounding, dose conversions, aseptic technique, the handling of sterile products, total parental nutrition (TPN), dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control and billing and reimbursement.

This course will include an optional 80-hour externship.

Additional fees for background check, drug test, TB testing, and NJ registration fees are students responsibility.

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, HS diploma/HSE, strong basic math skills, clear understanding of written and spoken English.
