## Government of Canada Creates Regional Relief and Recovery Fund

The COVID-19 pandemic has already had significant impacts on businesses, workers and communities across the country. This includes rural businesses and the communities in which they operate.

Last Friday, the Prime Minister announced nearly \$1 billion in support of these businesses, some of which will be administered through the CFDC networks, including the association of Western Ontario CFDCs.

Details on the CFDC component of the new Regional Relief and Recovery Fund (RRRF) are currently in development. At an operational level, the new RRRF fund will help businesses and organizations to help mitigate the financial pressure to allow them to continue their operations. It will also support projects by businesses, organizations and communities to prepare for a successful recovery.
