CODE OF CONDUCT



Winterfest provides an excellent opportunity for fellowship and interaction both among and between youth groups. Group leaders can also use it as a time to teach young people the importance of living their witness for Christ and letting their light shine to unbelievers at the conference and in the public. But in order for this to happen the following guidelines for conduct must be observed.

PLEASE MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO YOUR GROUP

- 1. All youth groups will be under the direct supervision of their group leader for the duration of the weekend. Each group leader must assume responsibility for enforcing this code of conduct.
- 2. Alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Fireworks are not allowed.
- 4. Backpacks will not be permitted in the Convention Center.
- 5. Each group will be responsible for any damage done to their rooms after check-in. payment must be settled with the hotel for the damage before departure.
- 6. All groups should be quietly in their hotel rooms by 1:00 AM Friday and Saturday nights. Remember that there are other guests in the hotel besides Winterfest delegates; we must show consideration to these other guests. Please refrain from excessive noises, loud talking in hallways and playing on the elevators.
- 7. Visiting in the hotel room of a member of the opposite sex is not permissible.
- 8. No prank phone calls. No prank fire alarms. Both of these violations may result in arrest, they are criminal offenses.
- 9. All groups should show respect to those in authority. Courtesy should be extended to those who make this event possible. Every group should behave at all times and in all places in a way that will bring Glory to God. We are a church group. People will be watching us closely; we must not bring reproach to our Lord and church.
- 10. We have received information from most of the hotels that a "3 Strikes" Policy will be enforced during our stay. If proper conduct is not maintained, the hotel staff will give those who are out of order a verbal warning. On the second offense the group leader and Winterfest support staff will be contacted. On third offense the group will be asked to leave the premises. Please be mindful of your actions.
- 11. All delegates must wear the Frontier Winterfest ID given to them at registration. No one is permitted to any session without ID!
